² My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. ⁴ But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing. ⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. ⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. ⁷ For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; ⁸ he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

8. What promises are being made in this passage?

10. Which words catch my attention to study later?

Testing, Produces, Complete, Reproach, patience, double-minded and unstable.

11. What does the Bible dictionary, concordance or other study tools say about these words? Write down findings.

Testing - trying, to prove genuineness, examine, verify, to check for
Produces - To bring about, achieve, accomplish, result in authenticity
Complete - perfect, mature, full grown, w/out spot or blemish, having reached its end.
Double-minded - doubting, hesitating, uncertain, wavering (divided interest)
Unstable - restless, not controlled by, unsettled, driven away, moved
Reproach - revile, mock, heap insults upon, blame, curse, to taunt

12. What other verses come to mind as I am studying these words? If none, pick a word and look it up in the concordance and find some other verses that stand out.

Double Minded . . . Ps. 86 (David Prayed) Teach me your way Lord that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an UNDIVIDED heart that I may fear your name (*unite my heart with yours)

COMPLETE : Phil 1:6 Being Confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus

Unstable: Rom. 8:5 Those who live by the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. →
